Membership Dues Amount: Individual dues are \$25.00, payable July 1st each year. Family dues are \$35.00, which includes all family members living in one household.

New members should prorate their first year's dues according to the quarter during which they apply:

Individual: July – September: \$25.00; October—December: \$18.75; January – March: \$12.50.

Family: July – September: \$35.00; October—December: \$26.25; January – March: \$17.50.
